

Four LGBT Leaders Take Seats at Solano County Democratic Party

1/23/2014 – Fairfield, CA – At the January 22 meeting of the Solano County Democratic Central Committee meeting, four representatives took their seats as new leaders of the Democratic party in Solano. Kristin Loomis, of Fairfield, President of the Northern Solano Democratic Club and David Crumrine, of Vallejo, Vice President of the United Democrats of Southern Solano County, won seats in January club elections. Craig Scott, of Vallejo, was appointed as District 1 representative. Stephen Hallett, of Vallejo, was appointed as District 2 representative. The four took the oath of office and their places as members effective immediately. All four reps are LGBT leaders within their communities.

The two clubs in Solano are chartered through the Solano County Democratic Central Committee. Each club is entitled, by charter, to a representative on the committee. The two other representatives fill open seats through nominations from other current committee members.

At the meeting, a resolution was passed which supports AB1266, the California School Success and Opportunity Act, the state law enacted as of January 1 which allows transgender students in public schools to use resources and facilities in accordance with the gender which they identify.
