The lake, which is shared by Six Flags Discovery Kingdom and Dan Foley Park has been the topic of a previous story on VIB and Bay Area Channel 11 because of debris either dumped in the lake, or allowed to enter the watershed through negligence on the part of Discovery Kingdom.
